Google services, other companies' services, and cookies

The Web Interface uses the so-called “cookies” for its activities. The Web Interface also uses Google Analytics and possibly other services provided by Google, Inc. in particular. (hereinafter referred to “Google”), Facebook Inc. or Automattic Inc. (hereinafter collectively referred to as “Other Companies”). Cookies are also used while using these services.

What are cookies and how do you express your consent to their use?

Cookies are text files stored on a computer or other electronic device of each visitor to the Web Interface that allow to analyse how the Web Interface is used.

Not all cookies collect personal information; some only allow the Web Interface to function properly. You can reject cookies using the appropriate browser settings.

By ticking the consent box on the Web Interface or by staying on the Web Interface, you give your consent to the use of cookies for the purpose of user support, the improvement of our services, including user behaviour analysis and marketing, as well as to the processing of your information by Google, Other Companies and us as described below.

What cookies does the Web Interface use and what purposes for?

The Web Interface uses **relational (temporary) cookies** that are automatically deleted after finishing browsing the Web Interface. Further, it uses **permanent cookies** that remain on your device until you delete them.

The cookies that the Web Interface uses are as follows:

- **First-party cookies** – these cookies are assigned to the domain of our site; these are necessary cookies and performance cookies; they may be temporary or permanent;
 - o **Necessary cookies** – allow navigation on the Web Interface and use of the basic features; they do not identify you and are not personal data;
 - o **Performance cookies** – analyse the use of the Web Interface (number of visits, time spent on the Web Interface etc.); the data obtained from these cookies are anonymous;
- **Third-party cookies** – these cookies are associated with a domain other than the domain of our site even if you are on our site; these cookies allow us to analyse our

site and show you tailor-made advertising; these are functional cookies and targeted and advertising cookies;

- **Functional cookies** – used to personalize the content by remembering logins, geo-location etc.; personal data may be obtained and processed through these;
- **Targeted and advertising cookies** – used to show targeted advertisements on and off the Web Interface; personal data may be obtained and processed through these. We may share information about how you use our site with our social networking, advertising, and analytics partners.

Can you stop storing cookies on your computer?

You can reject cookies using the appropriate browser settings.

Please note that if you reject cookies, you might not be able to make full use of all the features of the Web Interface.
